We had a successful nomination and selection process this year. Vandenberg Middle STEM teachers nominated 15 girls for camperships and Lompoc Middle nominated 12 girls. I met with the prospective campers and gave them camp and application information. CampDoc is the program used to provide application information with campers and their parents...everything is done online now. By the February due date, 6 girls had completed their application, which qualified them to move to the next step, personal interviews with Alice Down, Marell Brooks and myself.

The teachers had done a great job identifying qualified girls, which made our selection of 4 campers very difficult. Their essays and interviews were firstrate. Our 4 campers, Emma Jimenez, Zoe Martony, Nayelli Arguello-Medina, Rose Vega, will be stellar representatives for our branch.

Thanks to all of you who have the Tech Trek supported program, over the past 27 years, which has impowered so many past campers to continue to be involved in STEM activities.
